## **ORDINANCE 2014-01**

### **ADOPT WATER AND SEWER RATES**

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Shelby, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to set forth the rates, charges, and fees for the water and sewer utilities.

SECTION 2. Amended. Chapter 6-6-8 and Chapter 6-6-10 will be amended as follows:

#### **Chapter 6-6-8**

<b>Water</b>	<b>1-Jul-14</b>	<b>1-Jul-15</b>	<b>1-Jul-16</b>	<b>1-Jul-17</b>
Minimum fee/1st 1000 gallons	\$21.20	\$22.79	\$24.50	\$26.34
Charge per 1,000 gallons past minimum	\$5.83	\$6.26	\$6.73	\$7.24

#### **Chapter 6-6-10**

<b>Sewer</b>	<b>1-Jul-14</b>	<b>1-Jul-15</b>
Minimum fee/1st 1000 gallons	\$9.36	\$9.73
Charge per 1,000 gallons past minimum	\$1.56	\$1.62

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
