On motion by Richmond, 2nd by Rihner, the September 06th agenda was approved. Roll call: All ayes; motion carried.

On motion by Schlueter, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rihner, Housing grants for Andrea Norcott for \$5000 for the purchase of 502 Western Ave, and Noel Bailey for \$3800 for the purchase of 306 Des Moines was approved. Roll Call: All ayes; motion carried.
